Did we know?

The QFS has a patent. **US 12,354,089 B2.**

Assigned to Salesforce. Institutional holders: BlackRock, Vanguard, State Street.

It has no settlement layer of its own. It depends on the XRP Ledger — open source, neutral infrastructure that **anyone** can build on.

The escrow (~40B XRP) that fuels it? Confirmed transferable.

The rights can be purchased today.

The infrastructure is coming. The institutions are positioning.

The question is who holds the fuel.

Hold the fuel. Shape the road.

- **Clarity** on the two tracks being deployed — and how we could make **both** serve the living
- **Understanding** of why XRPL is different from what we have been told about blockchain
- **Learning** the different ways blockchain can reinforce sovereignty within our assemblies and communities
- **Our own wallet**, set up and ready to use — with our first transaction complete
- **The ability** to record a document permanently and transparently — without anyone's permission
- **Knowledge** of a strategic window that most people do not know exists
- **A clear picture** of how this connects to our assembly's operations — today, not someday
